Attention All Members:

Last year at Grand Convention amendments were made to the Grand Constitution and Statutes and the Auxiliary Rules and Regulations. The 3month dues payment grace period was shortened to a 1-month grace period.

All members who are 1month in arrears in their dues must be dropped by the Secretary from the rolls on the 1st day of July, or if the 1st day of July falls on a Sunday or a Holiday, then the next day following.








Our very own Harry Arthur has been chosen to go on his Honor Flight. Harry fought in the Korean War.


