Attention All Members:

Last year at Grand Convention amendments were made to the Grand Constitution and Statutes and the Auxiliary Rules and Regulations. **The 3-month dues payment grace period was shortened to a 1-month grace period.**

All dues expire on May 31<sup>st</sup> and are considered delinquent on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June. **All members who are 1-month in arrears in their dues must be dropped by the Secretary from the rolls on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July,** or if the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July falls on a Sunday or a Holiday, then the next day following.







Our very own Harry Arthur has been chosen to go on his Honor Flight. Harry fought in the Korean War.
