Attention All Members:

Last year at Grand Convention amendments were made to the Grand Constitution and Statutes and the Auxiliary Rules and Regulations. **The 3-month dues payment grace period was shortened to a 1-month grace period.**

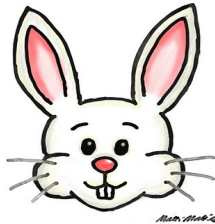
Spring has finally sprung! Wahoo! I hope you all enjoyed the sunshine last week. Boy we went from Winter directly into Summer!
