Attention: Auxiliary Sisters

We have proposed changes to our By-laws. Please note the following dates:

Attention: All Members

The parking policy has been updates. Please review the changes below.

WEST SEATTLE EAGLES AND AUXILIARY PARKING POLICY

- 1. All other Aerie parking policies are rescinded.
- 2. Parking at West Seattle Eagles #2643 lot is restricted to Eagles and Auxiliary members in good standing while using the club facilities and for 30 minutes thereafter.
- 3. When the Aerie has ben rented for an event, guests can park without a permit for the event and 30 minutes thereafter.
- 4. Vehicles must be parked within the marked parking spaces.
- 5. Only passenger vehicles (i.e. cars, pickup trucks, vans, suv's, motorcycles and scooters) are permitted. No campers, live aboard vehicles or trailers allowed to park.
- 6. Vehicles must display an Aerie parking permit on the left side of the windshield, so as to be easily visible for inspection from outside the vehicle.
- 7. Overnight, 24 hour and longer periods of parking can be approved by an Aerie Trustee or Employee, provided the vehicle's license number, owner's name and length of the time authorized is entered in the Aerie log book.
- 8. Vehicles may be removed/towed for failure to comply with these policies:
- A. Prior to towing a vehicle, an Aerie Trustee or Employee shall post or cause to be posted, a notice of violation on the vehicle.
- B. Such notice shall provide the date, time and nature of the violation. Also the date and time the vehicle is eligible to be towed.
 - C. No vehicle shall be towed within 30 minutes of the violation notice being posted.
- D. Authorization to tow a vehicle requires the approval of any two Employees or Trustees who shall record their approval in the Aerie log book.
- E. The owner of the towed vehicle may appeal the towing. It is the obligation of the owner to show why the towed vehicle was in compliance with the parking policies. If the appeal is successful, the member shall receive a refund the towing charge fees and 24 hours storage.
- F. Appeals must be in writing to the Board of Trustees within 72 hours of the time the vehicle was towed. The Board of Trustees shall review the appeal and make a recommendation at an Aerie meeting whose members will decide how the mater with be resolved.

As always, your opinion matters. If you have questions or concerns about these parking policies, please leave a note for the Aerie Officers in the Trustee Box in the hallway to the social room.
