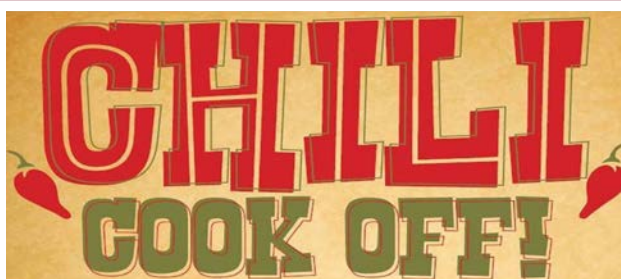

PWP Armando's fundraiser for his charity The Fisher House was unbelievable. Lot of good food and music! Thanks to all who supported Armando's charity.

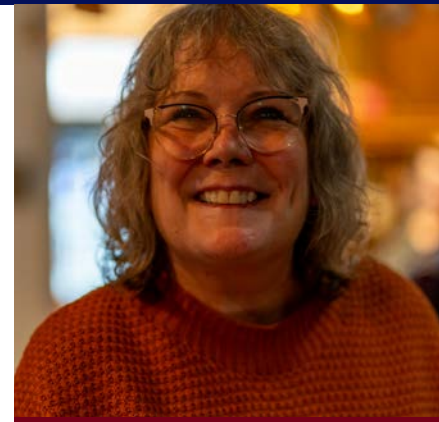
